What happens?

Between the ages of 6 and 12, primary teeth are gradually replaced by permanent teeth.

When?

While there's an average age around when each tooth comes in, it can vary from one child to the next.



Double row of teeth

The lower permanent incisors can grow behind the primary teeth. But the primary teeth usually fall out on their own, especially if they were already loose.

Appearance of teeth

Permanent teeth are naturally less white than primary teeth—that's normal!
